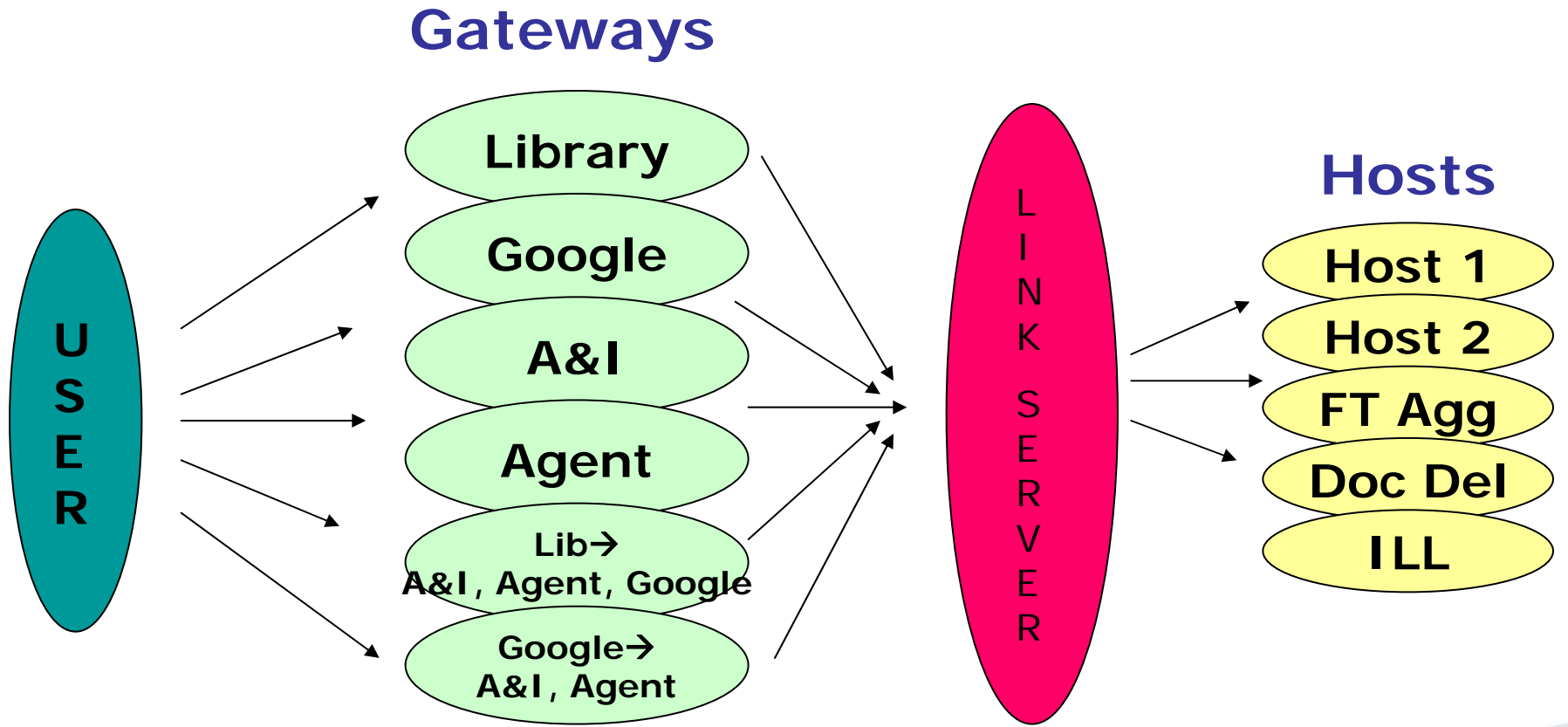
This presentation

- Librarians re-intermediated themselves in that navigation
- Publishers now need to work with library technology vendors to have their titles appropriately represented

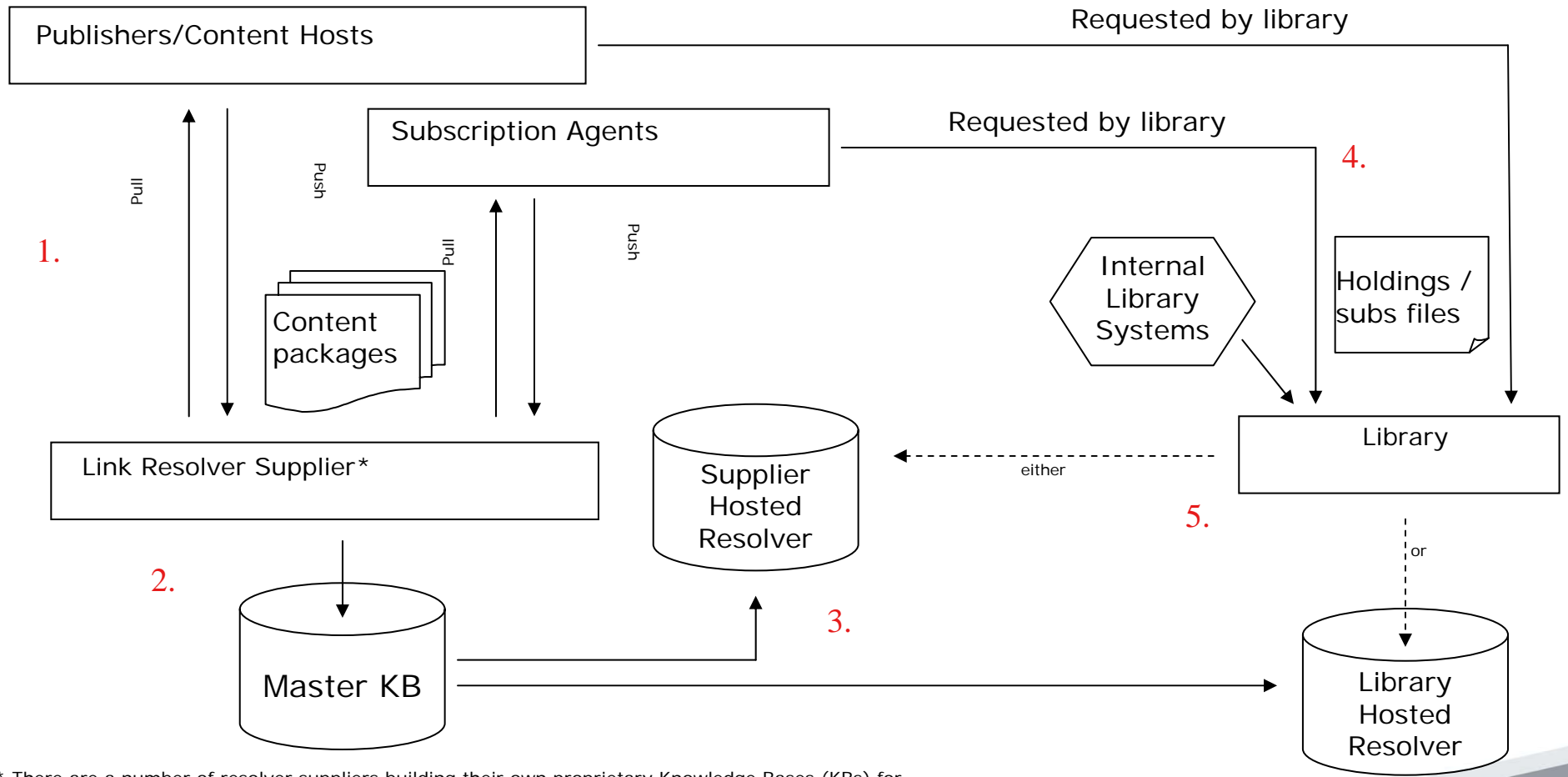

- Inbound Linking (OpenURL)
- Downloadable lists of subscribed titles (+URLs)
- Distribution of detailed site holdings to library systems technology companies
- Outbound Linking (OpenURL)
